Great Irish Famine Refugee Scholarship

We have established a Great Irish Famine Refugee Scholarship to support a current refugee student attending the Western Sydney University. The Great Irish Famine Memorial Refugee Scholarship recognises all those affected by the Great Irish Famine (An Gorta Mor, 1845-1850) and acknowledges the Irish Famine refugees who settled in Australia in the mid 1800s. The Famine refugee diaspora helped shape Australian culture and society and continues to influence contemporary Australian society today. We have established this Great Irish Famine Refugee Scholarship to honour our past famine experiences and support current famine refugees who seek refuge and solace in our country. Through this education program funding we offer an opportunity for a current refugee to advance their education in the belief they too will contribute to shape Australia like our Irish famine girls.

Our goal is to raise a minimum of \$30,000 a year to offer (at least) one refugee student a full degree scholarship of \$30,000. We ask you to donate generously to the Great Irish Famine Refugee Scholarship. This is a tax deductible donation.
